EXAMPLES OF EDUCATIONAL NEEDS STATEMENTS

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GENERAL BEHAVIOR NEEDS

- · The student needs to follow multiple-step directions in completing assignments.
- The student needs to maintain physical self-control in resolving everyday conflicts.
- · The student needs to improve test-taking skills.
- · The student needs to complete assignments within specified time limits.
- The student needs to organize personal belongings and classroom materials.
- · The student needs to seek assistance appropriately.
- The student needs to increase on-task behaviors using self-monitoring strategies.
- · The student needs to complete simple tasks independently.
- · The student needs to reduce/replace negative attention- getting behaviors.
- · The student needs to write down homework assignments.
- · The student needs to follow sequential directions.
- · The student needs to convey desires and feelings more spontaneously.
- · The student needs to improve study skills.
- The student needs to transition from activity to activity without getting into trouble.
- · The student needs to learn appropriate ways to respond to adult and peer questions.
- The student needs to participate fully in classroom activities.
- · The student needs to eliminate socially inappropriate body sounds in the classroom and at home.
- · The student needs to earn ____ credits this school year toward his/her regular / ESE diploma.
- · The student needs to earn a 2.0 grade point average this year.
- · The student needs to attend class regularly.
- · The student needs to focus on academics when in the classroom.
- · The student needs to work with others on team projects.
- · The student needs to consistently complete and turn in classroom assignments.
- · The student needs to increase his/her speed for completing classroom assignments.
- The student needs more materials/instructions presented visually rather than auditorally.
- · The student needs to increase his/her ability to communicate their feelings in a more acceptable manner

SELF HELP NEEDS

- · The student needs to improve self-care skills in dressing and grooming.

- •The student needs to acquire basic motor skills that allow him/her to move safely and/or purposefully in the classroom and at home.

- · The student needs to learn to identify safety signs on roads and buildings.

MATH NEEDS

- · The student needs to describe objects by attributes.

- · The student needs to be able to solve algebra problems.
