## **EFFECTS OF PUNISHMENT**

**Primary: Response Suppression** 

**Physical:** Pain, Fatigue

**Secondary: Unanticipated or Unintended** 

**Social:** On Persons other than Recipient

## UNDESIRABLE EFFECTS

**Emotional:** Fear, Anxiety, Crying, Hyperactivity

**Aggression:** Imitative-From Modeling

**Operant-Counter aggression** 

**Elicited-Displaced Aggression** 

**Escape or Avoidance: Withdrawal** 

Response Substitution: Other undesirable behaviors that increase if appropriate alternatives are not elicited and strengthened.

Response Facilitation: Paradoxical increase in punished behavior as a result of a) a weak punisher, b) opportunity to escape to a less aversive situation, or c) the "punishment" becomes a discriminative stimulus for reinforcement.

Negative reinforcement for user, and/or distress with self and/or role.
