Negative Outcomes for Students Displaying Antisocial Behavior at an Early Age

- ⇒ Peer rejection at an early age
- **□** Increases in off-task behavior in lower grades



- **⇒** Bonding with other antisocial students including involvement with gangs
- **⇒** Dropping out of school



- **⇒** Involvement in juvenile crime and later on adult crime
- **□** Ineffective relationships as adults
- **⇒** Inability finding and keeping employment
- **⇒** Serious mental health issues as adolescents and adults
