Presenting a Poster Session

Come prepared to the session to discuss your presentation. This is your opportunity to receive feedback and to generate new ideas about how to improve your future work.

Poster Construction Information

Coverage: Consider the following questions when reviewing your poster:

- 1) Have you provided the most important information?
- 2) Can someone walk away understanding your major findings after a quick examination of your material?
- 3) Will a more careful reader learn enough to ask informed questions?
- 4) Is the sequence of information evident?
- 5) Is the content being communicated clearly? Keep it simple. Place only the major points on the poster.
- 6) Provide a handout and your contact information.
