Classroom Management Skills

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- 1. Withitness an awareness of everything going on with all the students everywhere in the classroom.
- 2. Multitasking –the ability to deal with several students' problems simultaneously.
- 3. Responding to individual needs—tailor specific responses to particular students' needs.
- 4. Increasing positive teacher responses.
- 5. Avoiding escalation of problems—stamp out automatic reactions and responses that feed into and worsen misbehaviors.
- 6. Professional behavior—responding in ways that meet the needs of students not the personal needs of the teacher.
- 7. Being decisive—learning to act more quickly and staying in control of the situation.
