One in ten children between the ages of two and five suffers from an identifiable mental illness - a rate similar to that seen in older children and adults.

Disorders include:

- Depression
- Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder
- Oppositional Defiant Disorder



According to the research:

• 3.3% of the children studied met the criteria for ADHD.

Of those children,

- 44% have already been suspended from school at least once,
- 15% have been expelled
