Everyone is born free and equal in dignity and rights....The rights to:

- To maintain her or his own unique cultural, social, and spiritual identity without repression or oppression of any kind;
- To an education offering assistance in the full moral, creative, psychological, spiritual, and physical development;
- To work, including just, safe and favorable conditions, and to equal pay for equal work;
- To freedom of opinion and expression, peaceful assembly, and political association;
- To equal protection under the law;
- To travel freely within and among all states;
- To the past: to realize and enjoy humanity's accumulated legacy of knowledge, art, history, science and technology;
- To a future free of threat of annihilation from human-wrought cataclysm;
- To live in peace, free forever from the threat of violence and war.
